THE INSTITUTION

In 1982, Ishwar Charitable Trust was established with the paltry amount left upon the demise of Dr. Sushil Choudhry's mother. The Ishwar Charitable Trust was set up with the aim to provide affordable, preventable, curative and quality ophthalmic care to all sections of the community particularly the rural needy. The Trust, understanding the limitations of the rural poor, an effective and unique Rural Outreach Programme was designed in 1993 for providing modern ophthalmic services at the very doorstep of rural population covering the states of Haryana, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and the slum areas of Delhi. Operating on a hub and spoke model — screening and collecting patients requiring surgery from remote Rural Peripheral Centers (RPC's) and urban slums, bringing them to the base hospital (in NOIDA and Greater NOIDA) and providing them high quality diagnostic, surgical and post operative care at no charge.

ICARE EYE HSOPIATL AND WONDER FIBROMATS LIMITED

ICARE with the support of Wonder Fibromats has impacted the lives of many in FY 2018-2019 and to carry on the mission Wonder Fibromats Ltd has very kindly approved project for holding four more eye screening camps in the FY 2019-20. To provide ophthalmic services to underprivileged sections of our society living in Bhagwanpur district, Roorkee, Uttarakhand.

Publicity for these camps was done through pamphlets, banners by word of mouth, WONDER FIBROMATS LTD. staffs and other resources. Ambulances with teams of ophthalmologists and paramedical staff visited the camp sites on prefixed dates. People attending the camps were examined for refractive errors, cataract surgery were also examined for diabetes and hypertension which are very prevalent in the aged residing in the rural areas. Those requiring spectacles were refracted and spectacles dispensed to them free of cost kind courtesy to WONDER FIBROMATS LIMITED.

PROCEDURES FOLLOWED FOR PATIENTS CARE

Patients indentified for surgery were brought ICARE's ambulance and buses from the camp sites of Roorkee to the base hospital at Noida. A pre-operative detailed examination and investigation were carried out. Surgeries were performed the next day; some surgeries were postponed due to the patients being detected with other associated problems requiring medication and treatment. Surgeries were performed when they were found fit for surgery. On recovery from surgery they were transported back home in our ambulance bus, happy and satisfied that they have regained their eyesight and can once again be helpful to their families in the day to day chores of life and become an active member of their community.

CHALLENGES BEFORE SURGERY


Before going through surgery from ICARE Hospital, most of the beneficiaries were restricted to the boundaries of their respective houses due to age combined with low vision and it was becoming very difficult for them to manage things and spend time. Their dependency on the family was increasing, even for smallest of tasks, which started effecting the relationship too as it gave rise to small disputes inside the family. They were not able to do anything on their own, so one or the another member of the family had to be with them 24*7 which is not possible in today's fast pace life, especially for people at the bottom of pyramid as all major family members are involved in earning bread for the family and the minors are not mature enough to take care of elderly people. So the partial blind becomes more vulnerable and becomes the root cause for deterioration of one's physical and mental wellness. Due to partial blind moral of person falls to an extent that sometimes people kill their desire to live anymore.









Sarmal an old patient suffering from sight impaired from almost a year, he came to the eye camp supported by Wonder Fibromats Ltd. He be belongs from a very poor family, has three sons but nobody leads a good healthy financial status. Elder son is working as labour, second one works in a factory and third one is vegetable seller. Neither of his sons are capable enough to support their old parent's responsibility, hence Sarmal's eye health was neglected from a very long time.

His grandson heard our announcement of free eye checkup camp in his village and without any delay he went to the eye camp to get his eye test. On examination he was diagnosed with mature cataract, the counsellor in the camp counselled him for the free treatment and transportation. Sarmal happily got agreed for the treatment and boarded the ambulance along with rest of other patients. He was brought to the base hospital along with other patients. On reaching the hospital, he was thoroughly checked up with sugar, Blood Pressure and IOL lens power. On 4th Nov, 2019 Sarmal was scheduled for Right eye cataract surgery, his entire ophthalmic treatment, medicine, post operative goggles was availed by ICARE with the financial support of Wonder Fibromats Limited. He was happy to get his vision restored and thanked the entire ICARE medical team and Wonder Fibromats Limited for saving his eyesight and giving a new life. He can now perform his daily chores without difficulty and look after himself and his family well.

Anguri Devi is a 60 year's old lady from village, Bhagwanpur Raipur Roorkee, Uttrakhand, she has a big family with three sons and three daughters all married except her youngest son. Her husband works in small piece of land to grow crops for their livelihood. She was having problems with her eye sight for the last few months along with her blood pressure problem, but there was no one who could help her. She used to complain daily about her deteriorating eye sight but her husband neglected due to financial crisis.

One day she was sitting with her friends and she heard the ladies gossiping about the eye camp which was being conducted by ICARE Eye Hospital, Noida in association with Wonder Fibromats Limited. It was a golden opportunity for her as she also had her friend to accompany her for eye check up. At the eye camp she and her friend both were identified having cataract, when they were told about the free treatment by our doctor, a sign of relief was seen on their face.

She was brought to the base hospital for her ophthalmic treatment in ICARE's ambulance. All her pre operative examination was done the same day and on the next day her eye was operated for the removal of cataract. She is very happy now and living life with confidence. She is grateful to Wonder Fibromats Limited and doctors at ICARE for saving her eye sight and giving them an opportunity for leading a meaningful life.


